Missing Contact Info	No phone number, physical address, or licensed pharmacist visible? That's a deal-breaker.

No Secure (HTTPS) Connection	Your medical data could be intercepted.

If you encounter any of these, walk away. The short-term gain is never worth the legal, health, and financial fallout.

5. The “Discreet Shipping” Myth – What You Can Actually Expect

Plain Box	A brown corrugated box with no labeling, often stacked among other parcels.

If any item on the list ticks "no," pause. Your health (and freedom) depends on it.
